
STEPSTOOL OPERATION


TO OPEN:

Rotate the top step toward the front of the stepstool

TO CLOSE:

Rotate the top step toward the back of the stepstool






HANDRAIL OPERATION*


*NOT INCLUDED ON SOME MODELS

TO DEPLOY: Rotate the handrail upward until it locks into place. Make sure the orange hinge lock levers are fully locked in the downward position before using the handrail.



WARNING: THE HANDRAIL IS FOR STABILIZATION ONLY, AND NOT INTENDED TO SUPPORT BEING LEANED ON WITH FULL BODY WEIGHT. THE HANDRAIL AND TOOL TRAY HAVE A 25 Ib [11 kg] MAX LOAD.

TO STORE: Lift up on the orange hinge lock levers to unlock the handrail, then rotate it down toward the back of the stepstool. Make sure tool tray is empty before storing handrail.



NOTE: If the hinge lock levers are difficult to release, relieve the pressure on them by lightly pulling the handrail toward the front of the stepstool while releasing. Do not force the hinge lock levers with tools; permanent damage could occur.

PROPER SELECTION

- 1. Refer to NOTICE label for highest standing level, working load capacity, and contact information.
- 2. Select stepstool size to reach work without climbing above the highest standing level or over-reaching.
- 3. Weight of user, tools, and materials shall not exceed working load capacity.
- 4. Use an electrically non-conductive stepstool if contact with electricity may occur.

INSPECTION

- 1. Inspect before use. Do not use stepstools with missing, loose, damaged, or non-operating parts.
- Replace heavily worn feet and illegible labels. Never make temporary repairs of damaged or missing parts. Remove damaged or worn stepstools from service, and contact manufacturer for replacement parts.
- 3. Keep stepstool clean and free of slipperv substances.
- 4. Destroy stepstool if exposed to fire or chemical corrosion.

TRANSPORT AND STORAGE

- 1. Secure stepstool when transporting to avoid damage.
- 2. Store stepstool where dry and protected from unsafe materials, impact, or corrosion damage.

PROPER SET-UP & USE

- 1. Do not use stepstool if your judgement or balance is reduced by age, health, alcohol or drugs.
- 2. Lock stepstool in position and fully support bottom on a firm level surface.
- 3. Face forward when climbing up or when climbing down. Use extreme caution getting on and off stepstool.
- 4. Do not over-reach. Keep body centered over stepstool and keep stepstool close to work. Get down and move as needed. Do not walk or move stepstool while standing on it. Use care if pushing or pulling to the side.
- 5. Stand only on steps or platform.
- 6. Do not climb onto or off of stepstool from side or above, unless it is secured from movement.
- 7. Wear clean, slip-resistant shoes.
- 8. Do not touch energized electrical circuits while using stepstool.
